Find us ...

From Blackmoor Gate (at the Old Station Inn Pub), turn onto the A39 towards Lynton. Continue for 4 miles. After Parracombe, and just after 'Woody Bay Station', take the turning to the right, signposted 'Woolhanger'.

Follow Woolhanger Lane for half a mile to where the surfaced road ends. Continue along the track for a further 600 yards. The Manor and its car park can be found through the white gate on the right.
