The History of Castle Goring

Castle Goring is a magnificent and unique 18th century building regarded as one of the most important houses architecturally in the country. It was the first house ever built with a dual façade, Greco-Roman on the South side and Castellated Gothic on the North. Castle Goring is Grade I Listed and is located within the South Downs National Park with easy access via the A27 from Worthing, Brighton even London which is an hour and a half away.

The famous architect John Biagio-Rebecca, who was renowned in the Sussex area was the original architect. The South Palladian (Greco-Roman) aspect is yellow brick and is thought to be a copy of the famous Villa Lante near Rome. The Gothic aspect is constructed of flint and sandstone, and it was designed to replicate Arundel Castle which lies approximately 5 miles to the west.

Castle Goring is set within its own park of approximately 8 acres of land. The property has a number of fine rooms on the ground and first floors, with ornate ceilings and detailed plaster work.

Castle Goring has an intriguing history and is understood to be the only large house in Sussex built by the Shelley family. Sir Bysshe Shelley, grandfather of the great romantic poet Percy Bysshe Shelley, commissioned the property. Construction began in the 1790s and continued for a period of 15 years or more. The intention was that the property would be lived in by Percy Shelley, however, following his tragic death from drowning aged 29, this never materialised.

In 1825, the building was let to Captain (later Vice Admiral) Sir George Brooke-Pechell, fourth Baronet of Paglesham, and Lord of the Manor of Angmering, who was also the MP for Brighton from 1835-1860.

In 1835, Mary Shelley, who remains famous to this day as the authoress of Frankenstein, sold the property, which she inherited from her late husband Percy Shelley, to Brooke-Pechell. Brooke-Pechell's daughter, Adelaide married Sir Alfred F C Somerset. He was Deputy Lieutenant and Justice of the Peace for Middlesex. Their daughter Gwendoline married her cousin Arthur Fitzroy Somerset, the famous cricketer who held the same offices for Sussex.

The property was occupied by the Somerset family until it was requisitioned during the Second World War for use by the Canadian Army. After the war, the castle was let out to be used as a language school, as well as associated residential and business purposes. The property remained in the Somerset family until sold to the famous authoress, socialite and television personality Lady Colin Campbell in 2014.

The Ceremonial Hall

The Ceremonial Hall is a beautiful oval room accessed via grand double doors. Licenced for ceremonies, the Ceremonial Hall can seat up to 100 guests with additional room for standing. For more intimate weddings at Castle Goring, the Ceremonial Hall would be transformed into the dining area after a ceremony and will seat 70-80 guests.

The Ceremonial Hall is also the evening reception venue and offers dance floor and a full bar service for up to 175 guests.

State Rooms, Queen Victoria Rooms & Dining Room

On the first floor within the main building sit 3 large interconnecting State Rooms, perfect for the colder months for couples to enjoy reception drinks. The space has been decorated with wonderful art and elegantly furnished. For more intimate weddings the Dining Room can also be used instead of the Ceremonial Hall and seats up to 60 guests. There are also two smaller interconnecting rooms which can be used as chill out rooms these are the Queen Victoria Rooms.

Terrace

Our stunning terrace is also licenced for ceremonies and offers the perfect setting for an outdoor wedding. This is also another delightful space to enjoy your reception with guests spilling onto the South Lawns enjoying the tranquil surroundings or even a game of croquet. The balcony and staircases which adorn the back of the Castle link directly back into the Aphrodite Drawing Room so guest are also free to explore the property whilst you are busy getting those all-important photographs.

Marquee Weddings

For larger weddings at Castle Goring couples would dine within a beautiful clear span marquee located on the South Lawns. To take advantage of the stunningly elegant backdrop the marquee has a full clear span wall and gable end. The marquee has ivory lining with coconut matting or carpet.

Percy & Mary Shelley Bridal Suite

Our Bridal Suite is located to the rear of the Castle on the ground floor. The Suite is bight with 3 large windows flooding the room with natural light, perfect for those final touches before you head down the aisle. The suite hosts a beautiful French double bed and fantastic domed canopy. There are also comfortable sofas and statement furniture offering the perfect backdrop for pre-wedding photos. The bridal suite also has a large en suite bathroom with elegant roll top bath and shower facilities.

Lord Byron Suite

The Lord Byron Suite is decorated with a statement black and lilac colour scheme. The room is again furnished with French antique furniture and luxurious double bed. This Suite can be found on the ground floor to the rear of the Castle on the opposite side to the Bridal Suite. This room is included when a ceremony take place at Castle Goring for the Bride and Bridal party to use from 10am on the day of the wedding for getting ready.

Our Marquee is a clear span framed marquee with white PVC walls. We offer maxi-clear panoramic clear walls and ceiling panel. The interior is ivory lined from ceiling to walls with carpet or coconut matting as standard for the flooring. We can also source wooden hard floors upon request.

The marquee, with its clear walls and ceiling panels offers wonderful panoramic views of the South Terrace, Lawns and stunning architecture of the Castle. The marquee is a 'blank canvas' and allows couples to style the space to their tastes and theme.
